## Outstanding Technologist Award

Funded by the Education and Research Foundation for the SNM

The purpose of this award is to recognize an SNMITS member who has demonstrated outstanding service and dedication to the field of nuclear medicine technology. The winner will receive \$750 along with a plaque to be presented at the SNM Annual Meeting. Eligible candidates include SNMITS members in any area of the field of nuclear medicine technology who have exhibited commitment to advancing the field in their workplace and through their involvement with the Society. Nominees must be involved with the Society at the local, regional and/or national level and have at least five years of experience in nuclear medicine technology. Evidence of their outstanding work must be shown in the following required supporting documentation:

- Curriculum Vitae- including listing of publications, presentations, programs, awards and honors
- One letter of support from current supervisor
- One letter of support from a colleague
- One letter of support from a colleague who is a member of the SNMITS
- Completed Nomination Form

#### Letters of Support Guidelines:

*All letters of support must be 1-2 pages, typed.* Letters of support should highlight the nominee's significant contributions to nuclear medicine technology through their involvement in the Society and their workplace. In nominating yourself or another candidate for this award, you may wish to consider the following points. This list is not exhaustive. Please provide specific evidence.

- Has contributed significantly to the profession as a leader
- Has received local, national or international recognition
- Has enhanced the image of nuclear medicine technologists at the workplace, for the Society and/or elsewhere
- Has mentored others to make an impact in the field
- Has exemplified excellence in patient care

Candidates may be nominated by a colleague or may nominate themselves.
