Established by the family and friends of Dr. Tetalman, and funded by the Education and Research Foundation for the SNM, this award honors the research accomplishments of a young investigator who is pursuing a career in nuclear medicine. Dr. Tetalman was a highly respected and productive clinician, researcher, and member of the Society of Nuclear Medicine before his death as a young man.

Eligibility: Applicants must be 36 years of age or younger as of July 1 2007 and no more than 7 years from having obtained certification in nuclear medicine or nuclear radiology, or in completing a Ph.D. program. Applicants may be nominated by a member of the SNM or apply themselves.

Amount of Award and Presentation: A \$5,000 award check and plaque will be presented at or after the SNM Annual Meeting in June. This award will be offered every other year.

Deadline: Completed applications must be received by **November 15th**. If the deadline date falls on a weekend or holiday, the deadline will be extended to the next business day. Applications received after that date will not be considered.

Notification of Receipt of Application: The SNM will acknowledge the receipt of your application via e-mail within two weeks from the date of receipt. If you do not receive this notification, please call (703) 708-9000, ext. 1255 or email grantinfo@snm.org

Notification of Award: The recipient will be notified first by email, with a signed award letter sent in February.

Instructions: *We recommend using a computer in MS Word format to complete this application. No part of the application should be handwritten. Document space will expand when you type.*

This application must be completed in its entirety, and submitted along with the following:

- Current curriculum vitae
- A maximum of four (4) letters of recommendation, two (2) of which must come from the applicant's institution, and at least one of these letters must be from an SNM member. The nominator must be an SNM member
- A maximum of three (3) manuscripts and/or abstracts of grant applications submitted or funded describing the applicant's or the nominee's research efforts
- A letter (2 pages max.) from the candidate stating why he or she is qualified for this award.
