Established by the family and friends of Dr. Tetelman, and funded by the Education and Research Foundation for the SNM, this award honors the research accomplishments of a young investigator who is pursuing a career in nuclear medicine. Dr. Tetelman was a highly respected and productive clinician, researcher, and member of the Society of Nuclear Medicine before his tragic death as a young man.

**Eligibility:** Applicants must be 36 years of age or younger as of July 1, 2009 and no more than 7 years from having obtained certification in nuclear medicine or nuclear radiology, or in completing a PhD program. Applicants may be nominated by a member of the SNM or apply themselves.

**Amount of Award and Presentation:** A \$5,000 award check and plaque will be presented at or after the SNM Annual Meeting in June 2009. This award will be offered every other year.

**Deadline:** Completed applications must be received, not simply post-marked, by **Friday, November 14, 2008**. Applications received after that date will not be considered.

**Notification of Receipt of Application:** The SNM will acknowledge the receipt of your application via e-mail within two weeks from the date of receipt. If you do not receive this notification, please call 703.652.6795 or email [grantinfo@snm.org](mailto:grantinfo@snm.org).

**Notification of Award:** The recipient will be notified first by email followed by an award letter sent in February.

This application must be completed in its entirety, and submitted along with the following materials:

- Current curriculum vitae
- A maximum of four (4) letters of recommendation, two (2) of which must come from the applicant's institution. At least one of the recommendation letters must be from an SNM member.
- A maximum of three (3) manuscripts and/or abstracts of grant applications submitted or funded describing the applicant/nominee's research efforts.
- A letter (2 pages maximum) from the candidate stating why he or she is qualified for this award.

Applications for the 2009 Mark Tetelman Memorial Award must be received, and not simply post-marked, in their entirety by **Friday, November 14, 2008** in order to be considered.
